

Santa Claus Door Knob Ornament

Materials: pattern on this page copied on red construction paper; scissors; black crayon; white crayon or white chalk; white cotton balls (1 per student)

This is the part that will fit over the door knob. Add a cotton ball on the top of Santa's hat. Children love to hang this on a door knob and look at it!
