Growing Maize

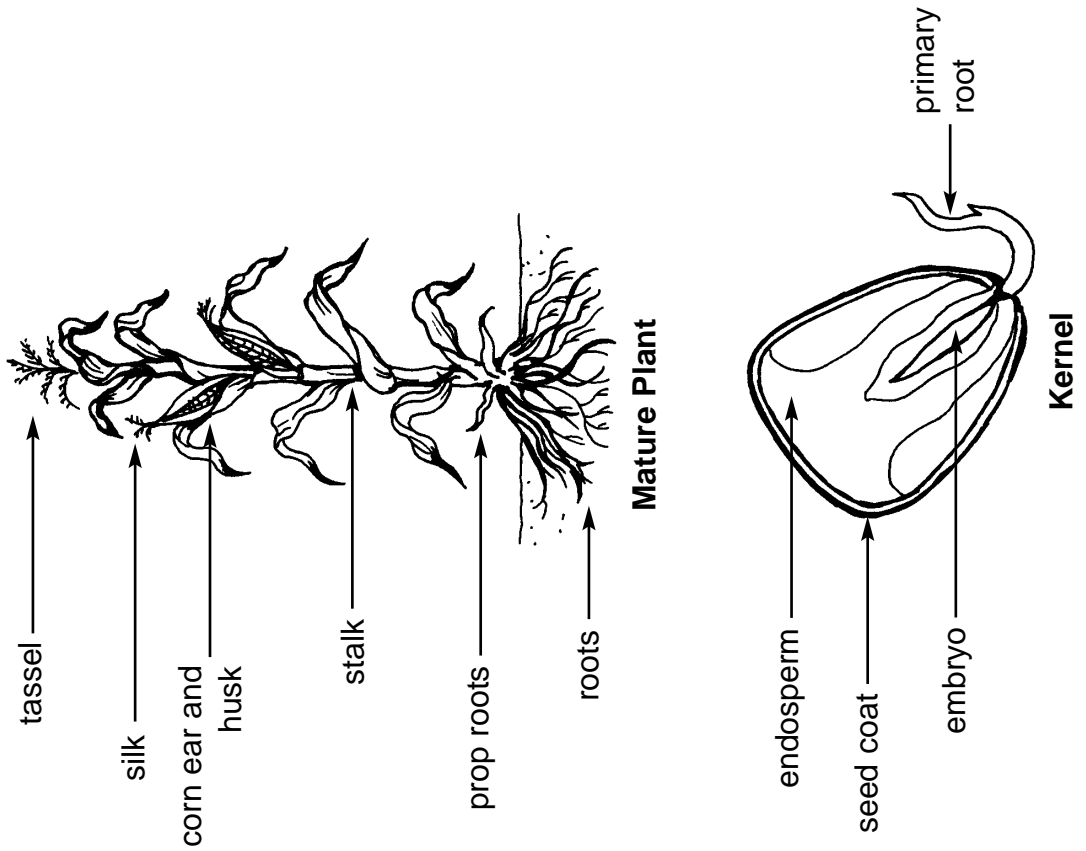
Maize is another name for corn. It was an important crop in the southwestern and eastern Woodland territories, and it was first cultivated in Mesoamerica thousands of years ago. To grow maize yourself, follow these directions. Then watch the corn grow.



Materials: corn kernels, moist potting soil, and self-sealing plastic bags

Directions:

1. Prepare a bag with soil. Fill the bag $\frac{1}{3}$ full.
2. Plant several maize kernels in the bag.
3. Water the maize kernels and place them in window light.
4. Observe your plants' growth. (Note: Within five days the first leaves will begin to emerge through the soil. Seedlings may be transplanted outdoors in warm weather.)
5. Predict the outcome of the growth.
6. Record your observations on the "Growth Chart." Use as many charts as you need in order to follow the complete growth process of the plant.
