
• • • • Telling Time to the Half Hour


When the hour hand is in between two numbers, the hour will always be the lower number. The hour is 3.

When the minute hand points to the 6, it is 30 minutes past the hour.

The clock on the right shows the hour hand in between the 3 and 4 and the minute hand on the 6. The time is 3:30 or half past 3.
