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Slam Dunk Telling Time

Objective: Students will practice telling time to the hour and half hour.

Preparation

1. Assemble and laminate the Slam Dunk Game Board (pages 84 and 85).
2. Laminate and cut out the Slam Dunk Basketball Number Spinner following the directions on the spinner page (page 87).
3. Obtain a token (any small math manipulative or even a bean or a bottle cap will work).
4. Laminate and cut out the Slam Dunk Basketball Cover Ups (page 89).
5. Cut out and laminate the Slam Dunk Directions (page 81).
6. Store the Slam Dunk Basketball Cover Ups, game token, and Basketball Number Spinner in a resealable storage bag. Label the bag with the game name label (page 175).

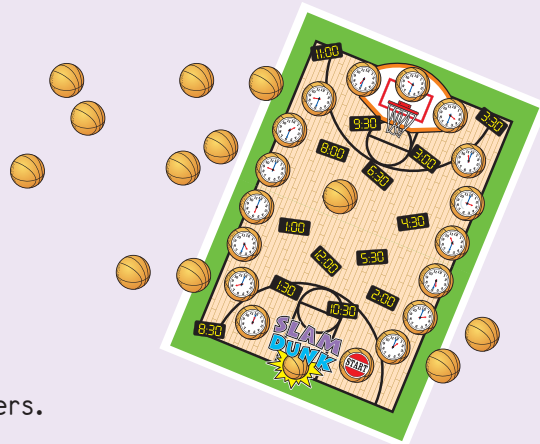

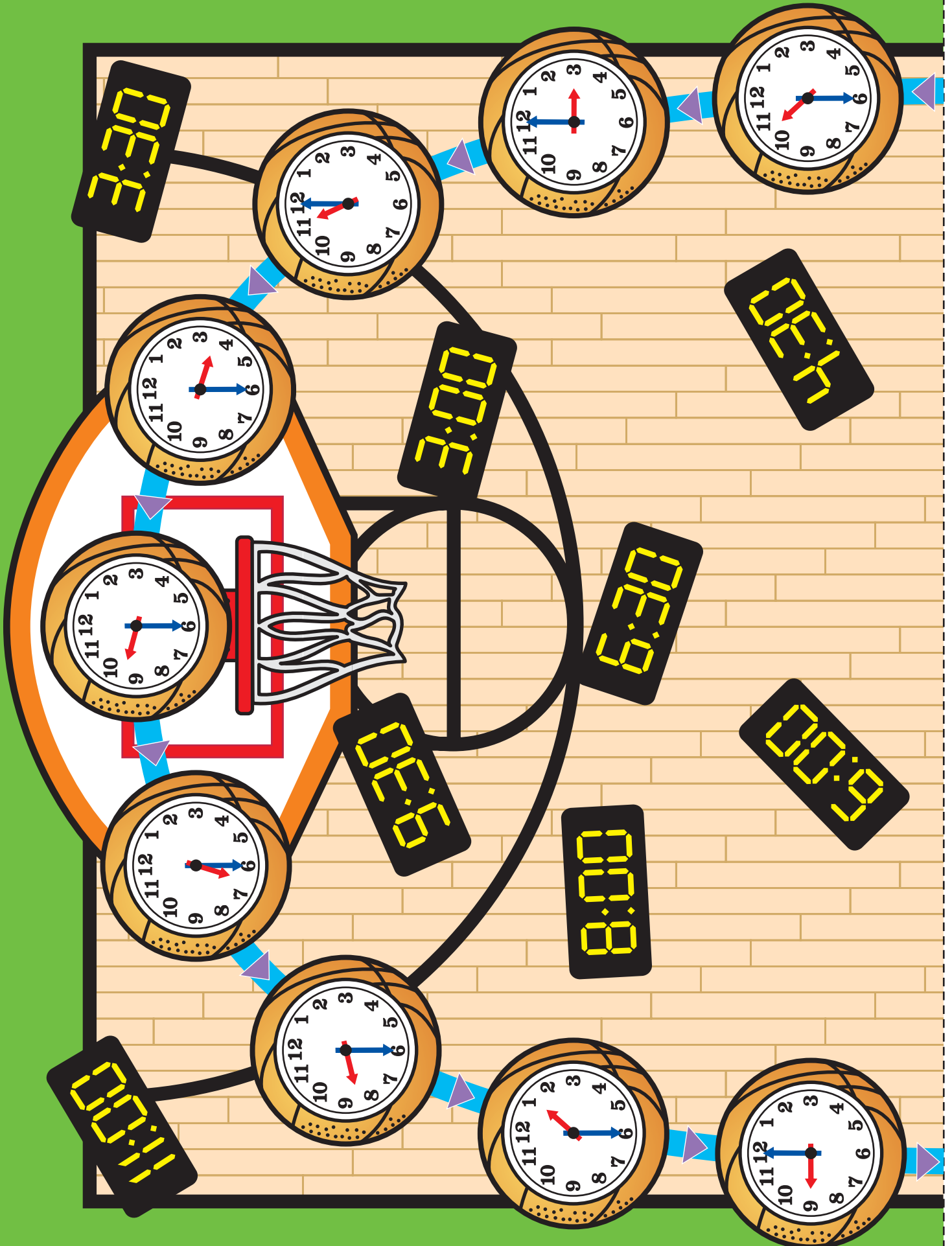

How to Play the Game

2-4 players

1. Divide the basketballs among the players.
2. Place the token on *START*.
3. Take turns spinning the basketball spinner and moving the token that number of spaces along the Slam Dunk game board path. Tell the analog time shown in the space on which you land. Use a basketball card to cover the matching digital clock on the Slam Dunk game board.
4. Continue taking turns until all the hour and half-hour times on the Slam Dunk game board have been covered.
