



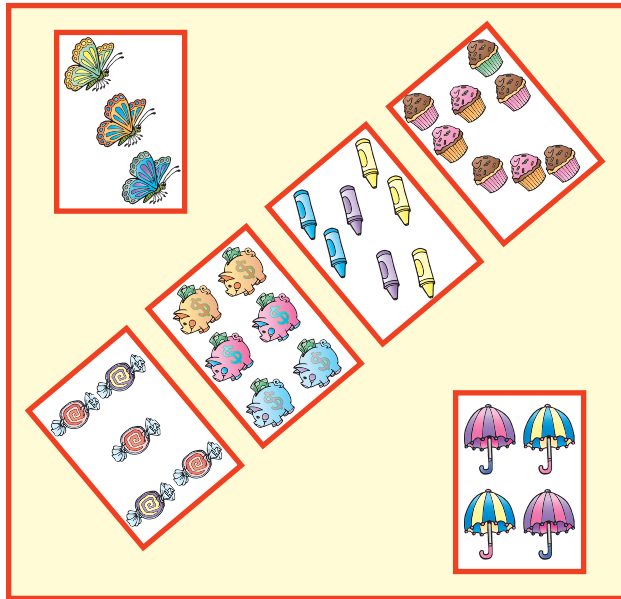

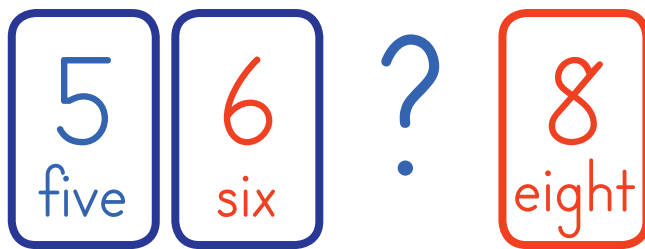


### Lay it Out

Ask students to lay out the Numeral, Object, or Ordinal Flashcards in order on the floor or on a table.

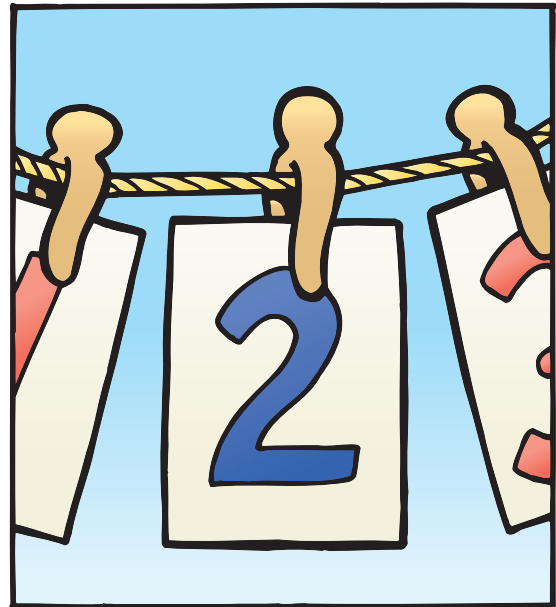


### What's Missing?

Lay flashcards out on a table or on the floor in order. Remove one or two, then ask students to tell what is missing. Students can then play in pairs; one student closes his or her eyes while the second student removes a card from the order. The first student then opens his or her eyes and names the missing card.

### Clip it Up

Let students use clothespins to clip flashcards onto a clothesline in order.

### I'm Thinking of a Number

Ask students to guess what number you are thinking of by telling them the number that comes before and the number that comes after it. For example, tell students, "I'm thinking of a number—it's between 5 and 7." Then ask them what the number is.



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
