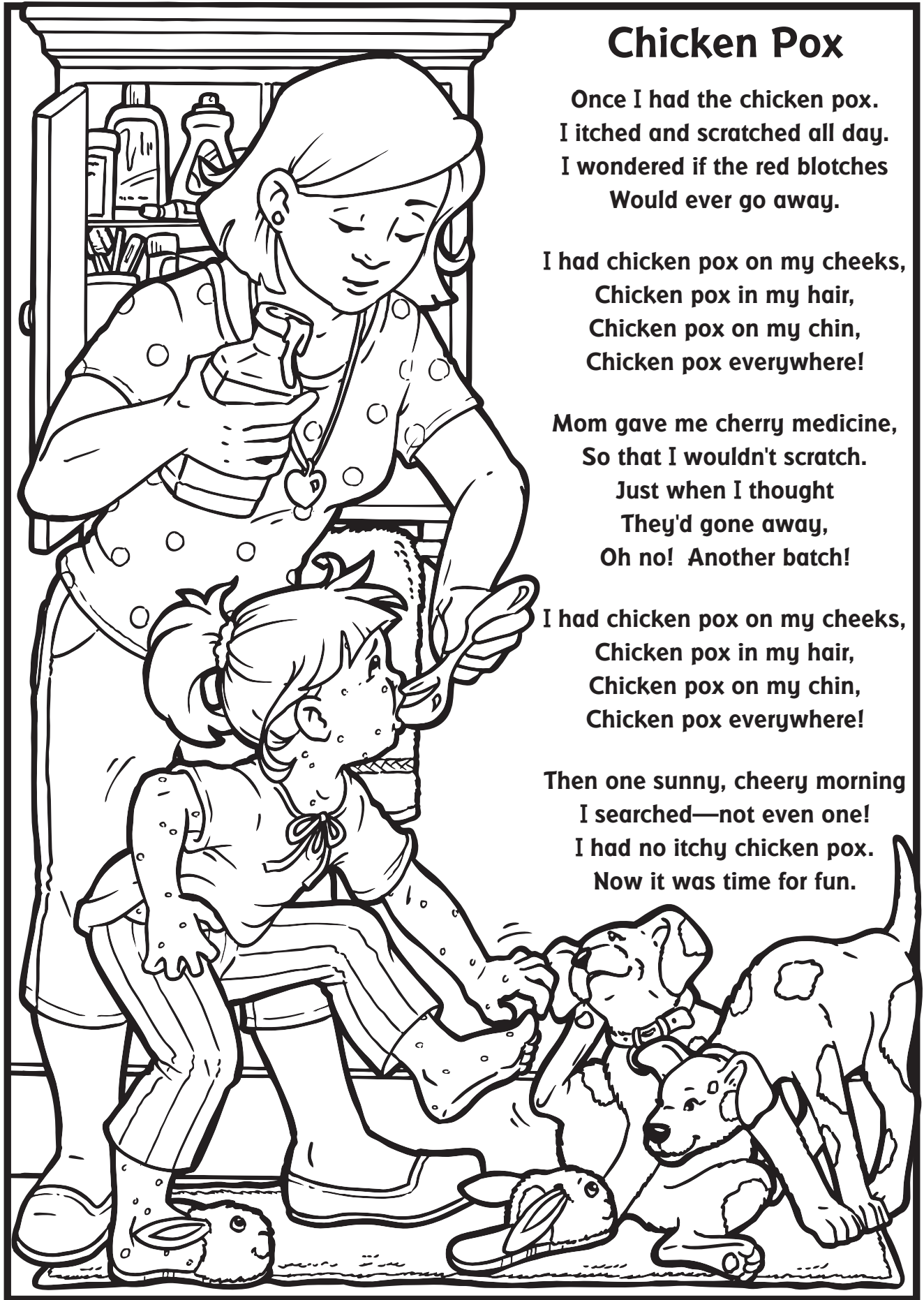


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Chicken Pox

Chicken pox everywhere!

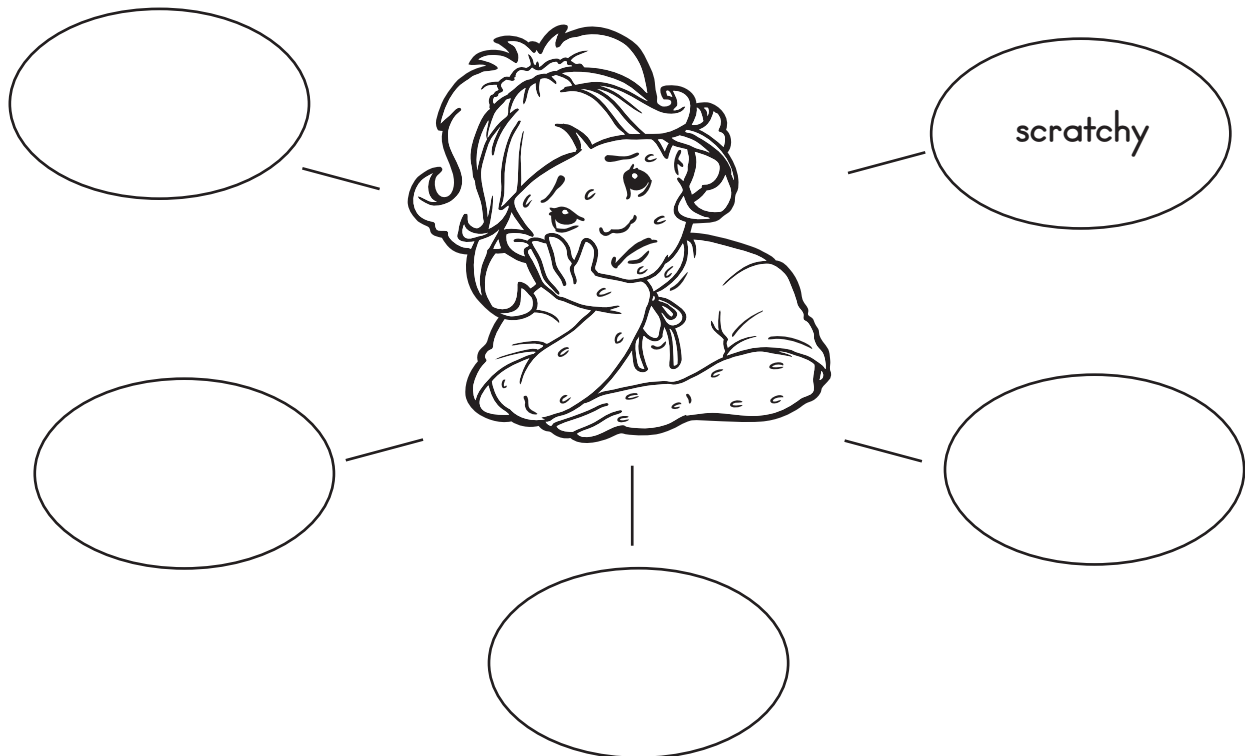
Then one sunny, cheery morning

Now it was time for fun.

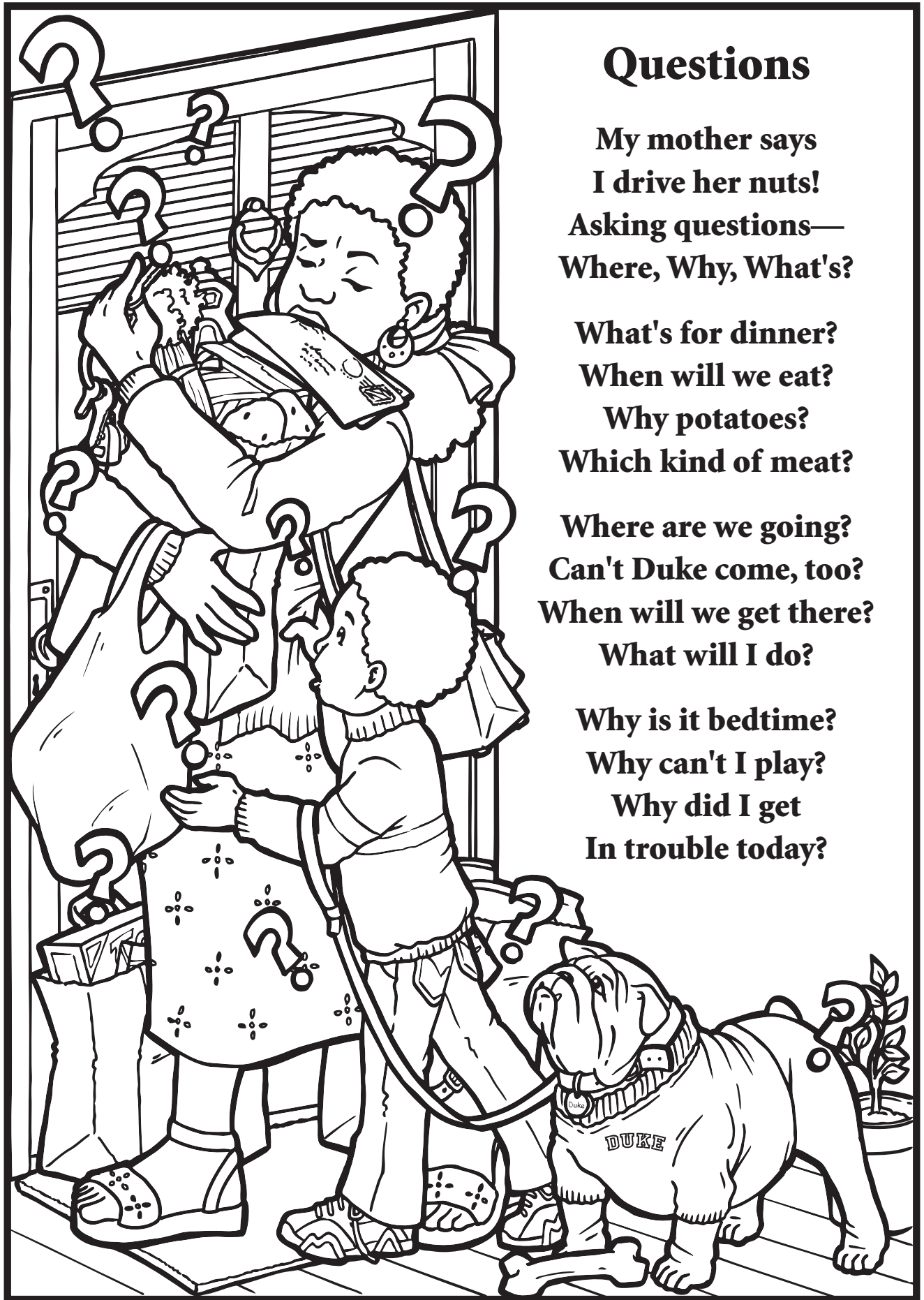
